

SOFT PLASTIC RECYCLING HERE

WHAT WE CAN'T RECYCLE



Rigid Plastics: Hard plastics that do not qualify as soft plastic recycling.

Foiled Bags: Heavy foiled or metallic-coated bags.

Contaminated Wrap: Any plastic wrap, film, or bag that is contaminated with food, liquid, or cannot be easily cleaned.

Cellophane: Non-recyclable plastic film.

Masks, Gloves, RAT Test Packaging: Includes disposable masks, gloves, and packaging related to rapid antigen tests.

Degradable, Compostable, or Biodegradable Bags: These materials break down differently than recyclable plastics and are not suitable for recycling in this program.

WHAT WE CAN RECYCLE



LDPE 4: Includes items like plastic bags, plastic film, and some plastic containers.

Cling Wrap: Must be clean and labeled as LDPE (resin 4).

Plastic Bags: Such as shopping bags, bread bags, pasta & rice bags.

Bubble Wrap: Cut large sheets into A3-sized pieces before recycling.

Cereal Box Liners: Clean liners from cereal boxes.

Chocolate & Muesli Bar Wrappers: Includes biscuit packets (wrapper only).

Coffee Cups PLA

Coffee & Tea Bags: Accepted if they have a light foil lining.

Confectionery Wrap: Chip packets with light foil lining.

Courier Packs: Plastic mailing bags.

Dairy Wrappers: Includes soft plastic wrappers from cheese and dairy products.

Dry Dog Food Bags: Includes packaging for dry pet foods.

Fresh Produce Bags: Includes netting from citrus bags.

Frozen Food Bags: Bags from frozen vegetables, fries, burgers, nuggets, and poultry.

Garden Potting Mix Bags: Ensure they are empty and clean.

Ice Pack Bags: Must be empty and dry.

Newspaper Wrap: Plastic wrap used for newspaper deliveries.

Plastic Packaging: Includes plastic around toilet paper, kitchen towels, nappies, and sanitary products.

Polyethylene & Polypropylene Bags: Includes reusable bags.

Toothpaste Tubes: Must be empty with the lid on.

Tetra Pak Liquid Cartons: Cut open, wash/clean, dry, and leave the lid on.
